MORE HYGIENE

The Hannover trade fair venue already has an infrastructure that guarantees the highest standards of hygiene. These measures will now be significantly expanded once again. For us, health protection and business development go hand in hand.



Disinfectants

Dispensers with disinfectants are installed in all areas of the exhibition grounds in a highly visible manner.



Cleaning

Door handles, handrails on stairs and frequently used surfaces are permanently cleaned and disinfected. This also applies to the sanitary facilities.




Hygiene rules

All participants will be informed about the basic rules of hygiene and conduct on the exhibition grounds (greeting without handshake, coughing/ sneezing into the crook of your arm, regular cleaning of hands, avoid touching the face).



Mouth and nose protection


Basically, all participants must wear a simple mouth and nose cover if the minimum distance of 1.50 m cannot be maintained.




Ventilation

Entrances, halls and conference rooms are permanently ventilated using our state-of-the-art ventilation systems.

MORE SPACING




The following measures will be implemented for the Hannover exhibition grounds in order to maintain the minimum distance of 1.50 m.



Minimum distance rules

All trade fair participants should be able to maintain the minimum distance of 1.50 m between themselves. Therefore, a maximum number of participants per event day will be specified for each event.

Exhibition stands must also be designed in such a way that a minimum distance of 1.50 m can be maintained between all persons present on the stand area.




More free space

The necessary distance rules must be observed in all areas of the fair (e.g. halls, entrances, conference and meeting rooms, catering). Should space enlargements be necessary for this purpose, they will be created.



Wider aisles

The aisle widths in the halls will be enlarged and additional open spaces will be created at heavily frequented points (in front of entrances and exits, at service points, in front of restaurants, cloakrooms and toilets).



Separate entrances and exits

In all areas of the exhibition grounds, entrances and exits will be separated from each other as far as possible.

MORE SAFETY



Numerous measures ensure that you will receive the best possible health protection at all stages of your trade fair visit. Be it in the trade fair restaurants, on the exhibitor stands or in your hotel.



Contact with health experts

Deutsche Messe AG is in constant contact with the relevant health authorities. Medical care on the exhibition grounds is provided around the clock.



Gastronomy on the exhibition grounds

The catering concept will also meet all legal requirements.



Registration of visitors at the exhibition stands

Exhibitors must register all visitors at the stand who stay 15 minutes or longer for consultation, negotiation or sales talks. The decisive factors are the visitor's contact details and the length of the conversation.



Online registration

Prior registration is mandatory for all participants on the exhibition grounds, including during set-up and dismantling. In addition, the participant must indicate to visitors on which days they will be staying at the exhibition grounds. This enables the control of the total number of participants on the exhibition grounds.
